

## How to Build Your Chessboard and Pieces

Ok...I thought that it would be a good idea to include a chessboard and pieces kit as well, just in case you found this subject on [my toy-and-game-inventor-success.com](http://my-toy-and-game-inventor-success.com) site, and didn't realize that you needed a chess set as well.

Construction is very easy, just glue both the board designs, (on the following pages) onto reasonably thick cardboard, (quality Hampton Mount board for \$7AU, a thin, stiff and white-throughout board is ideal for this application, but normal cardboard will do) making sure that you can **cut through it** later with a sharp knife (kids, its best to ask your parents to help you).

Then when dry, cut out the playing board, and also cut out all the playing pieces, (I have put all the pieces on both colored squares, so you only need to cut out **the squares**, which the pieces are on).

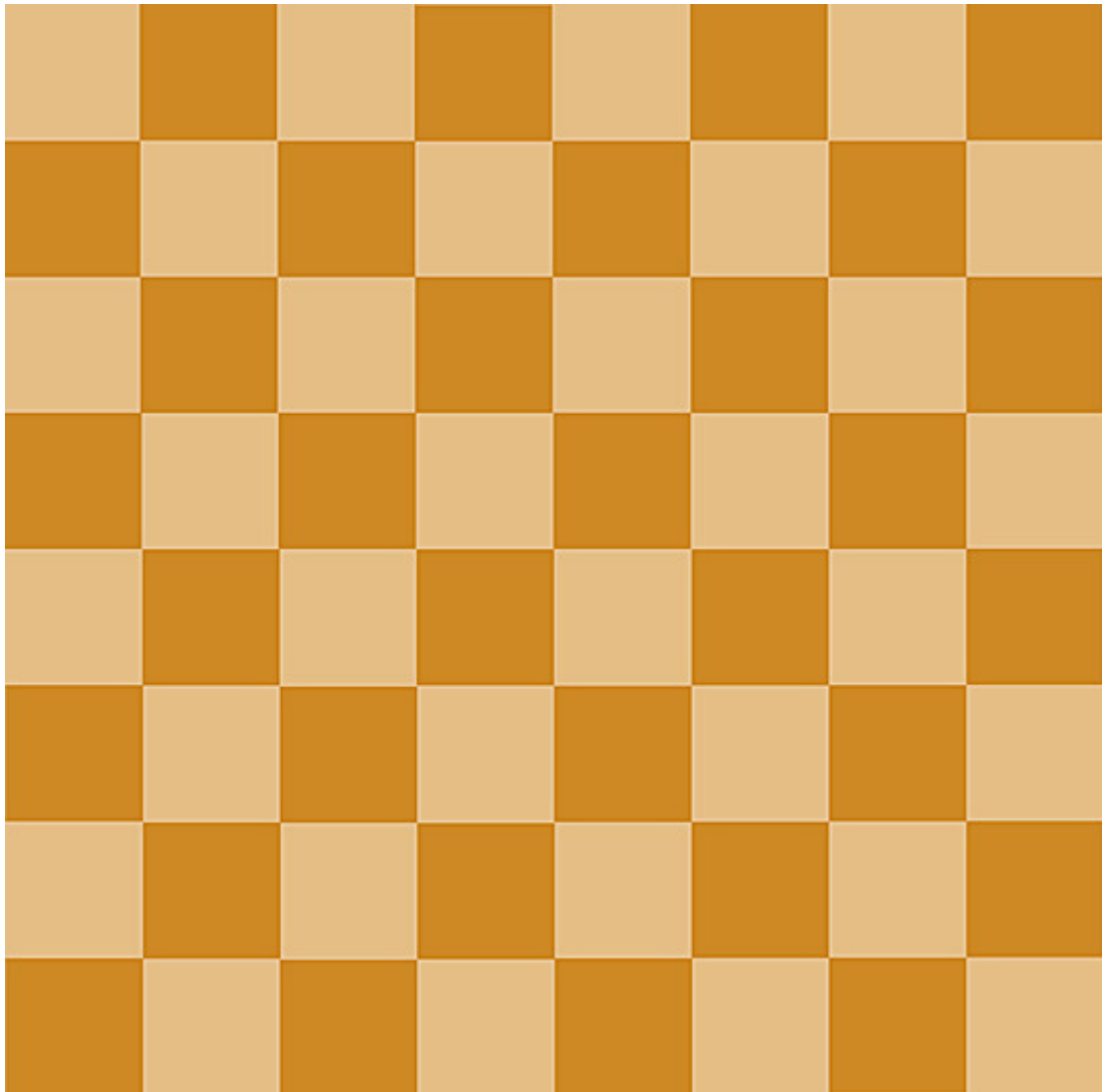
**Then that's it, you have your own chess set.**

The chessboard is intentionally slightly larger so the piece-squares should fit accurately, and will make a good temporary set, until you can invest in a proper chess set.
